### Prize

- Paid conference Fees for the Annual Meeting of ALHeLA held in Orange Beach on November 3-4, 2016
- One paid CE course
- Housing for up to 2 nights for recipient(s) from outside of the Orange Beach area
- ***Prize money will be reimbursed up to \$600***

### Requirements

- Entrants must be enrolled in the School of Library and Information Studies (SLIS) at The University of Alabama ***OR a resident of Alabama attending another library school.***
- Submit a 2-3 page essay on **one** of the following topics:
  - How are health sciences libraries managing changes in technology and/or digital content?
  - How are hospital and/or health sciences libraries providing outreach or marketing of their services?
  - How are health science librarians handling/minimizing workplace and professional stress?
- Essay is to be submitted to the ALHeLA scholarship committee.
- Essay must not be tied to any school assignment.
- Essay will be printed in an issue of *Synapse* and may be presented in person at the annual business meeting (scheduled during the conference).

### Deadline

- Essays must be submitted **no later than October 15, 2016** and applicants will be contacted shortly thereafter.
